Tactics from Bunratty


The following positions occurred in recent games at the Bunratty Chess Event.

In the position below, I captured the black pawn on a7 with my rook and I thought I was in a strong position to win the game. However, after spending a considerable amount of time (15 minutes) thinking about his next move my opponent came up with a forcing sequence of moves that resulted in us agreeing a draw in the game.

- 1. Can you find the moves that were played?
- 2. After the game, I analysed the position with the aid of a chess engine and discovered that black could play a different move that enables him to obtain a winning material advantage. Can you find this move as well?


